Model United Nations (MUN) Program

To be a delegate at the NHSMUN Conference in New York City, the student must fulfill the following prerequisites:

Academic:

1. The student should have demonstrated aptitude in:
 - a. Working in groups.
 - b. Cooperation.
 - c. Participation in group works even if members are not homogenous.
 - d. Diplomatic relationship with peers.
2. Have effective participation during classes especially in AmSS and BSS.
3. Fluency in the English language, both written and oral and be apt to present himself/herself publicly when questioned.
4. Demonstrate knowledge of contemporary and past facts so as to provide the student background to defend his/her position.
5. Have the ability and concentration to focus on deeper research on the proposed themes.
6. Passing grades are mandatory in all subjects.

Discipline:

1. Punctuality and presence is **mandatory** in the MUN classes at OLM and in any possible meeting outside school hours (including Saturday's and January 2011)
2. The student must not have had any suspensions in the 2009/2010 school year and in case he/she had a CDC in the same year, he/she will be observed by the coordinators of the event with the possibility of not being invited.
3. In case the student commits any serious fault or is suspended during the year of preparation for the Conference, he/she will be automatically dismissed from the group.
4. The students that participate of this event must always behave appropriately and have attitudes that are expected from a UN delegate during all of his academic life.
